PARENT'S Code of Conduct



As a **PARENT** representing the **Mission Soccer Club**, I will:

- Remember that my child plays soccer for his or her enjoyment, not mine
- Not force my child to participate in soccer
- Not give playing instructions to players during training sessions and games
- Encourage my child to play by the rules
- Encourage my child to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence
- Teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning
- Make my child feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and trying hard
- Never ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or losing a game
- Remember that children learn best by example applaud good plays/performances by both my child's team and their opponents
- **Ne**ver question the game or league official's judgement
- **S**upport all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from the children's sporting activities
- Respect and show appreciation for the officials who gave their time to provide sport activities for my child
- Make every effort to ensure my child shows up on time for scheduled training sessions and games
- Realize that the team can be penalized for my behaviour and that I must abide by the rules and the Officials at the field
- Must stand on the opposite side of the field from the Players and Coaches
- Not step onto the field of play during the game or designated training areas to avoid injury to myself or to players
- Wait 24 hours before contacting any coaching official and talk to them
 privately to resolve any issues that may have arisen during a game or training
 session

I understand that by not following the above Parent's Code of Conduct may result in my removal as a Parent from within the Mission Soccer Club
